NOTICE OF DECISION

AMENDMENT TO EXISTING WATERWORKS SYSTEM

In accordance with the section 74 of the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act, the City of Wetaskiwin has applied to Alberta Environment & Parks for an amendment of an existing approval to construct, operate and reclaim the cities waterworks system.

The application is to have the monitoring requirement of the parameter “Plankton” amended, which is in SCHEDULE 3 – TREATED WATER QUALITY: Limits, Monitoring and Reporting Frequency. The waterworks system consists of a treated water distribution system within the City of Wetaskiwin, and a water treatment plant with processes including chemical coagulation and flocculation, dissolved air flotation, rapid dual media filtration, disinfection by UV and chlorination, fluoridation and treated water storage.

The water source is surface water from Coal Lake. The treatment plant operation is located in SE of section 2, Township 47, Range 23, and SW of Section 1, Township 47, Range 23, West of the 4th Meridian in Wetaskiwin County.

Overview

Currently the City of Wetaskiwin is required to do quarterly testing for “zooplankton” in the clear well at the Water Treatment Plant. This amendment states we are now required to do quarterly testing in Garden Meadows Reservoir.
