The City of Wetaskiwin is committed to traffic safety and, as a result, is looking for a contractor to paint various long lines within the city limits. The City of Wetaskiwin is requiring the following lines to be painted this fall.

- 8,332m - white dash lines with spacing of 3m-6m 10cm wide lane lines.
- 297m - white dash turn lane 20cm 3m-3m for turn lane.
- 274m - white solid line turn back from the intersection 20cm.
- 7,507m - solid white shoulder lines 10 cm.
- 1,470m - double solid yellow 10cm/10cm/10cm.
- 8,522m - single solid yellow 10cm.
- 1,395m - yellow dash lines with spacing of 3m-6m 10cm wide centre lines.

The turn lanes are being changed to a 20cm line width. The existing 10cm are faded. To provide further clarification a map of the roads, along with the type of lines required, is attached.

Quotes will be accepted until 2:00 p.m. MST, July 21, 2021. Emailed quotes will be accepted at publicworks@wetaskiwin.ca. **NO FAXED TENDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** All quotes must specify a completion schedule.

Weighting used for awarding to successful bidder:

- Price - 60 per cent
- Previous Experience - 20 per cent
- Schedule/Completion Date – 20 per cent

The City reserves the right to accept a quote other than that of the lowest tender.
