

City of Wetaskiwin Uses Random Selection to Determine the Order of Eligibility for Local Cannabis Retail Applications

October 10, 2018

(Wetaskiwin, Alberta) – The City of Wetaskiwin has determined the order of eligibility for hopeful cannabis retailers by process of random selection. Conducted by an auditor to ensure impartiality, the random selection took place at 1:00 pm local time in Council Chambers at Wetaskiwin City Hall.

Thirteen applications were received by the City of Wetaskiwin, and were randomly selected in the following order:

10. Canna Cabana Inc. (104A, 5220-48 Ave)
11. 2107633 AB Ltd. (4905-51 St.)
12. Spirit Leaf Inc. (3727-56 St.)
13. Happy Daze (4901-49 St.)

“The interest in cannabis retail development in Wetaskiwin has been phenomenal,” said Lisa Novotny, Manager of Engineering & Development. “The random selection draw process provides administration an orderly manner to now consider development permit applications.”

Wetaskiwin City Council limited the maximum number of retail cannabis permits to be approved within the City to three. If any of the first three applicants cannot meet the requirements set out by the recently-amended Land Use Bylaw (1914-18), the City will notify the next applicant on the list. Wetaskiwin City Council also requested a review in 2020 to determine if additional retail cannabis licenses should be granted.

Non-medical cannabis will be legal across Canada as of October 17, 2018.
