RE: Trail Improvement Program

The WalkABLE Wetaskiwin Committee is a community group supporting all ages and abilities in Wetaskiwin to be active. Currently, our two priority areas include trail improvements and promotions / events. The work we are doing compliments the City of Wetaskiwin planning and strategic direction.

**What Needs To Be Done?**

Our first target for trail improvements is at By the Lake Park. Park users have identified two major concerns on the trails: (1) visibility and, (2) access to benches and garbage disposal areas. Our committee has established a Trail Improvement Program that has put together costs for needed trail items.

**How Can You Help?**

We are looking for donations or sponsors for the following items:

	Trail Items	Cost (\$)
1.	Concrete Pad and Bench*	2500
2.	One Solar Powered Bullard Light	1100
3.	Garbage Bin	800
	One Complete Trail Package (taxes included)	4400
4.	Dog Bag Dispensers	200
5.	Tree	350
6.	Light Only with Concrete Piling	1300

*\*Concrete pad and bench must be installed before other items.*

The City of Wetaskiwin will be providing preparation of the ground and installation of equipment as an in-kind donation. Placement of the trail items will be determined by the Public Works Department.

**Next Steps:**

The program works in the following two ways:

1. Be a donor – any donations received are designated to a City of Wetaskiwin account, where the committee will purchase needed trail items as funds are available. Charitable donation receipts can be provided.
2. Become a sponsor – purchase a specific trail item or a complete trail package. Sponsors are eligible for a plaque (already included in the cost) for the purchased trail item. Sponsors may also choose to remain anonymous.

If interested in participating in this program, complete the application form (see page 2) either online or in-person at the Public Works Office. Applications will be processed once payment is received, and Public Works will connect with applicants to discuss further details.
